Education:

Right to education:

Article 24 education state practice recognizes the rights of person with disability right to education, also mention to ensure inclusive system at all levels primary to higher education.

AP Government has been implementing various educational opportunities through SSA. It includes Bavitha centres in all 21 mandals of SACRED project area total number of children's. 242 Continued primary education in Bavitha centres.

RPD act 2016 provides free and compulsory education between the age group of 6 to 14 years has been fundamental rights, they have to be enrolled in schools.

Community care centers

SACRED implementing CBR approach to apply inclusive education total 467 Children enrolled in local regular village schools during 2020-21.

SACRED running 8 community Care centers run by SACRED through community care volunteer before and after regular village schools. Total 75 Children attending both community Care centers and enrolled in regular schools .

All schools going children and received benefits from Government schools, 467 children's have been accessed scholarships, books uniform and provided . There are 15 higher education students received laptops to attend online classes during covid-19 pandemic .

As many as 21 children's studying special schools, these children's provide smart phones to attend online classes provided by FVF special education centers. SACRED provided teaching and learning materials for primary school children.

Health:

SACRED CBR promoting health measures such as health education ,medical care, referring to High Institutes for Surgeries providing, mobility AIDS from SACRED Ortho workshop, Thuggali. Technical team conducted 10 camps in 21 mandals of project area 280 PWD screened and referred to workshop and other institutions, total 360 PWD's medical bills support 50% of the amount reimbursed from SACRED under referral total of 13 PWD referred to higher institutions such as BIRRD Tirupati, GSR Hyderabad, RDT hospital Anantapuram, for surgeries.

SACRED organized special campaign with collaboration of Aliyavarjang National institute of hearing disability of Hyderabad and Delhi, 180 persons with hearing impaired assessed and issued Audio gram by audiologist and provided by lateral hearing AIDS for children and adults on 24th and 25th of March 2021 at Thuggali field office. A total of 120 persons received Hearing AIDS. It is significant development activity supported by government to SACRED during this year.

Awareness camp on Covid-19 by ANM

As we are all aware about covid-19 First wave the whole world trouble during the covid-19 pandemic. It is all difficult times challenging to SACRED, even though SACRED staff intensively followed preventive measures during covid-19 pandemic. we work with government to follow the measures such as total lockdown period in the country during this time SACRED provided masks and distribution of pamphlets for awareness, frequent cleaning hands, not to travel, avoid gatherings. All SACRED staff followed mobile contacts with SHG members ,DPO leaders and other community members during the lockdown period.

Parents Meeting were organized for 210 children with disability especially focused on therapy intervention , 120 Children physiotherapy training, 54 activities daily living skills ,35 Speech therapy followed during the reference period.



Therapeutic interventions

Due to regular training and follow up parents gradually tangible improvement found during the reference period. Parents expressed their positive feedback , acknowledging, their interest and efforts during one year period.

About 395 mental ill Persons referred to psychiatric camps in Anantapur. 320 accessed treatment from government hospital. It is observed 265 persons regularly taking medicines and responding for the treatment. 125 mentally ill persons who showed significant improvement after medication and counseling. SACRED 25 persons provided livelihood activities engaged to lead independent life.

Spinal cord injury :

Sacred special focus on spinal cord injury persons rehabilitation on CBR model. Total 59 persons affected spinal cord injury in project area. Almost all the families became very vulnerable due to family heads majority of them are income earning people. In this context sacred implementing special program provided medical support such as reimbursement of medical bills, providing dry nutritious for all 59 persons, apart from other requirements such as catheters, urine bags, waterbed ,wheelchairs and walkers, physiotherapy etc..

They expressed impact of SACRED effort in helping and supporting 59 families in order to bring the development with (Spinal card injury) persons and increase their health conditions.

Livelihoods:

703 villages formed 897 SHG in 22 revenue mandals, running thrift and credit activities, 1310 PWD's have taken loan to an extent of INR 1,31,00,000/- from them Mini banks, DSDP and Bank linkages and other livelihood opportunities. They are managing livelihood activities such as Dairy farm, ram lambs, cycle repairs, mobile service center, mee seva center, petty shops, chicken centers, tea shops and fast food centers.

The families of PWD's very worries and struggled during covid - 19 pandemic. SACRED supported financial assistance to maintain the family income during difficult times.

skill development:

SACRED supported 55 sewing machines provided for 55 disabled women who were trained in tailoring and embroidery . They are earning of 6000 per month. They are very independent living with dignity . Now the family income increased because of their contribution.

18 women with disability joined skill training centre at RDT Anantapur, due to covid-19 pandemic they are provided materials and other requirement and assed them work from home.



Youth for Job:

Employment:

34 Men and women got employment in restaurant, garments, malls and small companies. Under the scheme, each person receiving salary Rs: 12000 to 18000 per month. Because of their job the family member provided equal respect and dignity and independent life.

Under MGNREG scheme Government of India implementing and providing livelihood security to the rural poor. The objectives of the scheme provides livelihood security to the people in rural areas by guaranteeing at least 150 days of wages employment during the financial year.

Total 2164 PWD's accessed MGNREG work during the reference period 38 Days received job opportunity and earned IRS 1, 31, 57,120/- It is suitable scheme for rural poor people.

Disabled people organisation (DPO):

It is a significant development among the networking from SHG's to mandal level federation to regional level federation. The objectives of DPO's were mainly working in advocacy. These DPO once in 2month meeting at mandal level and regional level.

The federation members improved leadership qualities, capacity and they ability to sensitize PWD's to access all the resources and services from the government. They are able to ensure the RPD act 2016 which are available schemes, services, and opportunities in RPD Act and discussed the various platforms.

During federation meeting they discussed the social issues and talk by involving PWD's for example kothiralla village, pattikonda mandal named Ms.Veeralexmi, Mentally retarded girl child by local man immediately SHG's informed to DPO members and discussed about the issue of the mentally retarded girl and reported to the lawyer Mrs.Sasikala, Lawyer. Lawyer is very positively support to mentally retarded girl. The man and family members called to court and file the case. Finally the girl received social and financial support through justices.

SACRED main focus to promote 3 DPO's, they are:

1. Aadharsha disabled People regional federation
2. Vennela women with disability federation
3. Trinetra carers association

SACRED CBR future strategies to promote 3 federations and function for the advocacy and sustainability. Their Objectives to act upon the issues such as sadaram medical certificate, government schemes ,house sites and housing program, employment opportunities, 4% job reservation implement 2016 RPD act, , and state political reservations etc.. from state and central Government.

Vennela women with disability federation:

The main purpose of vennela federation to prepare the platform to discuss disabled women issues and strength their capacity through empowerment and emancipation. The problems found during the pandemic women have faced several challenges, household issues, problem in working place, health, economic issues, particularly unmarried , unemployed in rural. Women had in most situations women over burden at household care giving for the family members, health problems of elder women, lack essential resources like ration, medical care, lack of finances.

Trinetra carers association:

This Platform will focus mainly careers issues and their recognition by the government the careers in specific severe problems facing 7 type of disability careers, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and illness, multiple disabilities, Autism, paralysis and spinal cord injuries. SACRED careers program able to organise state level care forum by virtual meeting both careers worldwide and SACRED along 6 NGOs partners participated in the meeting, discussed about the issues of cares during covid-19 pandemic. Further discussion all should play a role in reality and no care is left behind. Trinetra careers association establishing and strengthening their capacity to meet government departments at mandal and district level for the careers recognition.

Political and Electoral:

Felicitation electoral rights of PWD's. The Government of India empowered in consultation with the election commission rules that regulate manner in which voting given both general and person with disabilities. In this Context assistant director disabled welfare, have invited NGO to participate in local elections to create awareness for the people with disability to contest and vote during local election 2020. Assistant director created WhatsApp group for this purpose, all SACRED staff involved during this election in providing appropriate accessibility such as ramps, provided with wheelchair facilities in all elections booths where there are hearing impaired ,visual impaired people the sign boards displayed at election booths.

As per the RPD Act 2016, state parties explained disable people participation in cultural life recreation, leisure and sports. Central government made a policy for PDW's have equal opportunities in sports recreations and cultural activities. The libraries has been organised digital libraries, recreation and sports. School age children's participating sports and games at village level. Most of the village school encouraged disabled children to play with the able body children.

K.R.Pally --- Mango garden, Anantapur

252 plants growing very healthy and natural. This year mango fruits harvesting have come up increasing yielding. The people those who have taken for lease very satisfied and benefited. They have shown interest to take up lease for the next year also. We have conformed the lease price for the next 1,20,000/-. This year the water source increased because storage of water in Anantapur tank. We are planning to keep strong and high fencing around the garden to protect mango fruits.

Areca Leaf Plates, kurugunta village, Anantapur

The project proposal prepared with the help of local technical marketing person in the presence of Mr.Dider cadau and send the proposal to Action for Disability to purchase for machine and infrastructure development at Kurugunta SACRED resource center for the year 2020-21.

Areca / palm leaves as resource material from Karnataka. These leaves are grown up naturally in areca nut plants, most of the times this leaves burned or fired by the farmers. However they can also brought in the usage of bio-degradable leaves. They will soaked in the water and pressed into shapes to make plates, cups and bowls. They are sustained in future in place of plastic plates and bag are affecting environment pollution, they are made from an agriculture bio-product in place of plastic.

SBI Account Opening

Government of India Ministry of Home Affaires amended ex-ordinary FCRA New rules published by the authority, New Delhi 28th September 2020. Ministry of Home Affaires brought the bill to Parliament, New Delhi on 10th November 2020 notified GAZETTE of India.

All NGO's from all over India asked to implement FCRA rules from the date amendment by Ministry of Home Affairs. Further Ministry of Home

Affaires to open the new FCRA Account designated SBI, New Delhi, Main branch(NDMB).

SACRED followed to implement new FCRA Act. First step to organize SACRED Emergency meeting to discuss about FCRA amendment brought into force 28th September 2020. The SACRED board members conducted general body meeting on 30th December 2020. The board members passed resolution to open new FCRA Account at SBI New Delhi main branch (NDMB). All board members unanimously approved to open the bank account. The members of the board authority to the president to proceed by following guidelines FCRA Amendment 28th September 2020 to open the bank account through local state bank of india branch, Anantapuram. These process will take long time to fulfill the document by all general body members.

International disabled day celebrations

In all 21 mandals of kurnool project area celebrated **world disabled day on 3rd December 2020** to begin the rally in all mandal head quarters possessed by People with disabilities, mandala vikalangula samakya leaders and carers participated in this event. The Government officials from various departments, Mandal Revenue Officers, Mandal Development Officers, Bank managers are participated during public meeting. The Government officers explained about the schemes, benefits from Government departments particularly for people with disabilities. The schemes such as pensions, subsidies, loans, housing, insurance schemes provided Aids and Appliances Etc.. from Government and NGO's.

SACRED has great opportunity regarding Ms.Aina and Ms.Felitha from FVF to visit SACRED CBR Project in the month of March. She visited Mr.Mahadevappa who is suffering with Spinal car injury at Obulapuram village, Devanakonda mandal . She received all about previous story and present status of Mr.Mahadevappa. Ms.Aina and Ms.Felitha showed lot of concern . Both of them appreciated the efforts of SACRED to bring changes with Mr.Mahadevappa.

In the afternoon visit, they met federation of Vennela Women with Disability general body members meeting at IKP office, Pathikonda. They also has opportunity to meet the careers of Mental health persons in Thuggali. After interaction with these groups, she expressed huge appreciation to SACRED CBR program. They inspired to learn and visit the programmes of SACRED CBR.
