Creating awareness on COVID-19

- SACRED received huge support from RDT, Government providing Masks, Nuitrition food Distribution for Spinal Cord Injury persons, lonely women, all PWD members and Carers will get each person 2 masks about 16000 masks for 8000 PWD's and Nuitrition food for 58 Spinal Cord Injury(SCI) Persons.We are grateful to our Donors RDT,AFD, CWW(UK),PPF(Switzerland) provided total support to manage present situation.

Nuitrion food : It is important everybody has to improve the immunity, when the body improves body immunity easily fight with CORONA VIRUS. To ensure this factor,we have to provide Nuitrition food simple, available green leafy vegetables to fight with CORONA VIRUS education is important.

MGNREG Program: It is highly benefited program for PWD families to get wages daily from the program, totally money weekly once credited in to their accounts. Member at present exercising job opportunities in most of villages by PWD's and Carers.

Free Rice: Government of INDIA and State Government have provided Free Rice each person 10kgs per month along with Dhal, Vegetables like wise for

3months granted during COVID-19 Lockdown period from April to June 2020. It is a huge support provided by Government of INDIA.

- **Personal and Surroundings hygiene:** They are educating very important area personal hygiene such as hand wash with soap and water, bathing after the work, using sanitizers if they are available and maintain the cleanliness surroundings. Government support this program.

- **Refferals:** People cautioned particularly affected fever, cold, cough, throat pain or difficulty in breathing, they should consult the doctor or any nearest medical person or Health Worker in the Village.
- SACRED preparing education material on **CBR/CBID workers Guidelines**, and **Good notes from John hopkins University** translated in to Telugu SACRED and RDT using to train the staff, PWD families and Total Community. These documents we have received from Mr. Balakrishna Venkatesh(Venky) containing lot of useful information on CORONA VIRUS-COVID_19 prevention management and also to understand CORONA VIRUS-COVID-19 features etc.

We are in the process of translation in to the local language and printing the material to train the staff to teach in the community by staff.

In all SACRED staff RDWs and Co-ordinators, Director has been communicating by phone calls, Whatsapp message, video conference by Zoom App in creating awareness, sometimes to distributing food and masks RDWs,Co-ordinators personally they will visit villages to fulfill the task.



Guidance for CBR/CBID Workers

Guidance for CBR/CBID workers (this includes paid and volunteer workers) in the COVID-19 pandemic

CBR/CBID workers have a very important role to play in the COVID-19 pandemic. Their actions can help to protect and support persons with disabilities, families with members with disabilities and vulnerable members in the community such as the elderly or homeless. In doing this, they will be in turn protecting the whole community.

1. CBR/CBID workers should only visit communities for essential purposes such as delivering food, water or medication. When such visits occur, care should be taken to maintain physical distancing. CBR/CBID workers are encouraged to contact families and or community members by telephone (text or whatsapp app) on a regular basis to keep them informed, gather information about their needs and discuss ways in which these needs can be met.
2. The key messages that are developed and relayed by the CBR/CBID program should be based on the local context and regulations and also take into consideration the following issues that are based on Person-Centred Emergency Preparedness tool (PCEP)
 - a. Know your local hazard/ risk in relation to COVID-19;
 - b. Make a plan together with community members on what is to be done and who is responsible to include persons with disabilities and other vulnerable members.
 - c. Get your community motivated and ready
 - d. Be aware of changes in the situation and adjust your plan if needed
 - e. Facilitate inclusion of persons with disabilities/ family members in the livelihood activities.
 - f. Look out for each other.

These six points can form the basis of ongoing telephone/text/email contact with the communities that workers are already responsible for.

3. Know your local hazard/risk.
Community workers need to familiarize themselves with the local situation as far as they can. CBR/CBID workers need to ensure they are familiar with all of the rules and practices set out by their government and to collaborate with their local structures to see how they can work together to ensure that the needs of persons with disabilities are always considered in planning and subsequent action.

4. Make a plan together with community members on what is to be done and who is responsible.

Where possible telephone families and individuals known to the community service and make a plan together with them. Try to make sure that the needs of people with disabilities are being considered in the local strategies that are being implemented.

These strategies will vary according to individual circumstances but for example might include:

1. కోవిడ్-19 మహమ్మారి సమయంలో సిబిలర్/సిబిడి కార్యకర్తలు దాని ముఖ్యమైన పాత్ర పోషించే వలసిన అవసరం ఉంది. వారి దర్శన వికలాంగులను, వైకలాగులున్న కుటుంబాలను మరియు వృద్ధులు లేదా నిరాదరణల వంటి సమాజంలో నిరాదరణకు గురైన వారిని రక్షించడానికి మరియు మద్దతు ఇవ్వడానికి సహాయపడతాయి. ఇలా చేయడం ద్వారా, వారు మొత్తం సమాజాన్ని రక్షించిన వారు అవుతారు.

2. సిబిలర్/సిబిడి కార్యకర్తలు, ఆహారం, నీరు లేదా మందులను పంపిణీ చేయడం వంటి ముఖ్యమైన అవసరాల కోసం మాత్రమే సంచారాలను నిర్వహించాలి. ఇలాంటి సందర్భాల సమయంలో, సామాజిక దూరాన్ని తప్పక పాటించాలి, తగు జాగ్రత్తలు తీసుకోవాలి. సిబిలర్/సిబిడి కార్యకర్తలు, వికలాంగుల కుటుంబాలకు మరియు సామాజిక సభ్యులకు, సమాచారం ఇవ్వడానికి వారి అవసరాల గురించి సమాచారాన్ని సేకరించడానికి మరియు ఈ అవసరాలను తీర్చేటట్లు మార్గాల గురించి చర్చించడానికి ఫోన్ (టిక్ట్ లేదా వాట్సప్ యాప్) ద్వారా లేదా సందర్శించడమని ప్రోత్సహించాలి.

3. సిబిలర్/సిబిడి ప్రోగ్రామ్ కోసం అభివృద్ధి చేసిన మరియు ప్రచారం చేసే ముఖ్య సందేశాలు స్థానిక పరిస్థితుల మరియు నిబంధనల ఆధారంగా ఉండాలి మరియు వ్యక్త కేంద్రీకృత అభ్యవసర సన్నద్ధత పాఠసం (PCEP) ఆధారంగా ఈ క్రింది సమస్యలను కూడా పరిగణనలోకి తీసుకోవాలి.
