Out of 4 Childrens, he is 3rd born with blindness. Parents were disappointed to have son with blind. They consulted Doctor in Kurnool. Doctor said he is totally blind, he will Not get sight. He married a Women with Physical Disability in the year 2007.

He has identified by SACRED staff and formed sangham in the year 2008. After Sangham formation he has received all security benefits from Government, such as medical certificate, Pension, train pass, Bus pass, Ration card etc.. Mr. Mabbasha regular person to attend SHG meeting





monthly Saving Rs 50/- per month in Sangham. He has received Rs. 5000/- through bank linkage and began vegetable selling, his mother Shavasamma assisting him in business. He is very bold person to go to market and buy all types of vegetables.

besides this he has started mobile recharge card business by accessing loan provided from SACRED and Cordaid. His mother appreciating his efforts to be independent and live with Dignity. Bothe of them said that they are very grateful to SACRED and Cordaid for given such type of opportunity to grow in community.
